

The Tivoli Congress Center will host the exhibition and lectures of the BIBM Congress 2021.

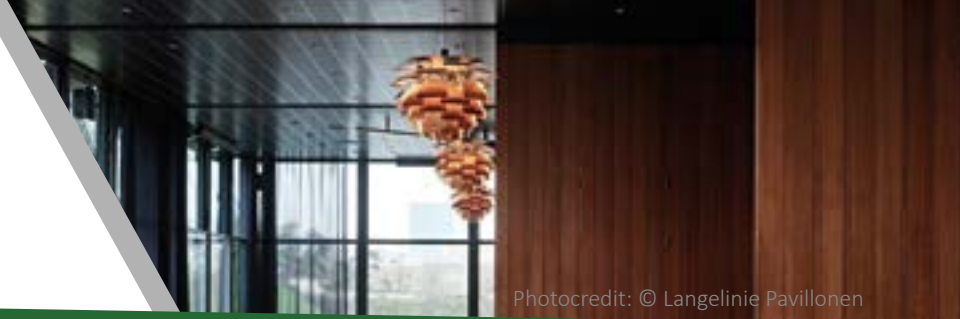
