BIBM welcomes its new President and Vice-President

Brussels, Belgium - September 28, 2023 - The Federation of the European Precast Concrete Industry (BIBM), at its General Assembly held during the BIBM Congress on September 28, 2023, has elected **Stefan Van Buggenhout** as the new President for the term 2023 – 2026. He is the third Belgian to hold this prestigious position, after Patrick Declerck (2011-2014) and Raf Bulcke (1981-1984).

During the meeting, the General Assembly also elected a new Vice-President, **Ignacio Brujó Sánchez-Harguindey**, who is the General Director of Memorial Parks S.A. and a Spanish representative on behalf of ANDECE.

The Federation expresses its deepest gratitude to the outgoing President, **Bart van Melick**, CEO of BTE Holding B.V. in the Netherlands, for his dedicated service over the past three years.

Stefan Van Buggenhout has had a long career in the concrete sector. Since 2012, he has been the Managing Director of CRH Structural Concrete Belgium, a leader in precast concrete products. He was also the chairman of FEBE asbl, the Belgian precast concrete federation, for seven years (2014-2020). He is currently also the Vice-Chairman of FEBE. Over the next three years, under President Van Buggenhout's leadership, BIBM will continue its mission to advocate for a stable, business-friendly legislative environment at the European level, focusing on the challenges facing the concrete sector. Stefan Van Buggenhout is committed to working towards closer collaboration between members and other players in the construction sector. He will strive for an equal playing field for the precast concrete industry, emphasizing energy efficiency, sustainable construction, and
